



Teach Grant

**Receive up to \$4,000 per year (full time) with a total of \$16,000 for undergraduate study
\$8,000 for graduate study**

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

1. Maintain a 3.25 GPA or score above 75th percentile on ACT/SAT
2. Declared major in one of the following high-need teaching fields:
 - Bilingual education
 - English as a Second Language
 - English/Language Arts/Reading (4 – 8)
 - Foreign Language (Languages other than English)
 - Mathematics (4 – 8 or 8 – 12)
 - Science (4 – 8 or 8 – 12)
 - Special Education
 - Reading Specialist
3. *Commit to teach 4 years in a low-income school
